



THE CLASSES

All Cars - general

The 2020 Time Attack Championship is open to cars of any recognised manufacture or body profile that are, or have previously been, available as a production vehicle, other than in the new-for-2020 Prototype class. Any modifications to the chassis/body must be submitted for pre-approval by the Championship Scrutineer. Single-seaters and open-wheeled vehicles are not permitted. In all cases, please refer to the published Championship Regulations.

Run What You Brung

The Run What You Brung category is open to any car that's based on a production model. Provided it's fitted with a hand-held fire extinguisher and 4-point harness, then it's pretty-much ready to go. Any spec and any tyres are permitted. RWYB competitors will run in their own sessions that mirror those of the main Time Attack Championship.

Club Classes

Clubman and Clubman+

An entry-level category for mildly modified cars and ideal for those used for trackdays. The class is split into Clubman for lower-powered cars and Clubman+ for higher-powered cars.

Pocket Rocket FI (Forced Induction) and NA (Naturally Aspirated)

A class for smaller cars and hot hatches that are fitted with an engine no larger than 1600cc with forced induction or 2240cc naturally aspirated. Tuner modifications are allowed.

Club Sport

Club Sport is a class specifically for lightweight track orientated cars such as Caterhams, Westfields and Ariel Atoms.

Club

The most popular level of competition for road-based cars that can be modified to a certain level. The class is split into two categories for 2WD and 4WD cars. Sequential gearboxes and flat floors are not permitted.

Pro Classes

GT3 & Sportscar

Open to any category of GT car, whether or not it is currently homologated. These include GT1, GT2, GT4, GTE and other models from Europe, Asia and the USA. Racing slicks and wets can be used.

Prototype

New for 2020, the Prototype class is for cars that have been specially manufactured for competition or as a limited production run. These include LMP1, LMP2, LMP3 and specials. All must comply to Motorsport UK regulations and be fitted with operational lights.

Club Pro

For modified cars and those with sequential gearboxes and flat floors, but running on treaded road-based tyres in the dry. Racing wets may be used when it rains. The class is split into two categories: 2WD & 4WD.

Pro

For highly modified cars. Racing slicks and wets can be used. The class is split into two categories: 2WD & 4WD.

Pro-Extreme

As long as it's based on a production model, almost anything goes! The class is split into two categories: 2WD & 4WD.

Classic & Retro

This class is for cars that are based on vehicles that were produced 25 or more years ago. Regulations according to the Club and Pro classes apply accordingly. Classes are defined when the technical specifications are known.

Tyres

All Club class cars are to use tyres from the Pirelli Trofeo R range. Alternative Pirelli tyres from the Motorsport UK 1A and 1B lists may be used in wet conditions. Club Pro competitors use Pirelli Trofeos and Pirelli racing wets. Pro and Pro Extreme classes use Pirelli racing slicks and wets. There are exceptions for Club Sport cars and those that require a unique size of tyre that cannot be supplied by Pirelli - subject to approval by the Championship Organisers.
