TICKETS

ARRIVAL & PADDOCK ACCESS

Friday: Those of you taking part in the test day will receive your arrival time and venue information direct from the circuit. Arrival for those not taking part is from 14.00. This is strictly the earliest arrival time. Competitors will be turned away and not allowed to queue on the narrow public roads leading to the circuit. Setting up in the occupied areas of the paddock and pit garages cannot take place until participants taking part in the track day have vacated. This event concludes at 17.00 Keys for the pit garages will be available from Mark - Championship Secretary - from 17.30 - 19.00 on Friday. After that, please ask circuit security.

Saturday and Sunday: Venue access is available from 7.00am. Competitors may stay overnight in the paddock on Friday, Saturday and Sunday and must vacate by 08:00 on Monday.

VENUE INFORMATION

Entry is via the main circuit entrance. Competitors in the pit garages should park in the designated area behind the garages. Competitors without a garage should bring their own shelter and power supply and set up in the Time Attack paddock area (see plan). Please park trailers in the area indicated on the plan.

Please remember that the paddock and pits area is accessible to the public, so keep your area clean tidy and safe and make sure you don't leave tools and equipment unattended. You may stay overnight in the paddock.

SIGNING ON & DRIVERS' BRIEFING

Signing on will take place in the office in the centre of the pit garages building below Race Control from 07.00 on Saturday morning.

A drivers' briefing will be held in the Paddock Clubhouse at 09.30. All drivers must attend. If you're not there, a penalty will be applied. Drivers who are new to Time Attack will be asked to stay-on for a further safety briefing.

BRIEFING NOTES: A set of briefing notes will be issued ahead of the meeting. Please read when received.

Following the briefing - and during the weekend - we are planning to shoot mug shots of all drivers. For the sake of your own publicity, your cooperation is appreciated.

SCRUTINEERING

Scrutineering will take place in the Scrutineering bay from 07.00 - 10.00 on Saturday. Please note the briefing times so that you can scrutineer your car without missing the meeting.

IMPORTANT: Please ensure your car is well prepared and ready to be scrutineered. Delays are caused when cars or equipment is either not presented correctly or poorly prepared. Therefore, please check the basics: extinguishers, harnesses, seats, driver controls and operational lights. If the scrutineers find any significant issue, you will be sent back to your team area to effect repairs and then have to re-join at the back of the queue.

If you are missing any stickers or competition numbers, these can be collected from the Office when you sign on. Your car will not pass without them.


