

TIME ATTACK CHAMPIONSHIP: SEASON SHOWDOWN

The 2025 Time Attack Championship has been another year of close competition, mechanical drama, and record-breaking laps across the UK's best circuits. With the final round at Snetterton still to come, some classes are already settled while others will go right down to the wire.

Here is a class-by-class look at where the battles stand and who could come out on top:



CLASSIC & RETRO CUP

1st: Marc Donnelly 🏆

2nd: Dean Riley 3rd: Michael Greenhough

The podium in this class is already confirmed. Jamie Biss sits fourth but switched class mid-season which makes him ineligible for third. Eden Young is in fifth after a 100-point deduction and also cannot climb back into the top three.

CLUBMAN

1st: Annie Thomson



2nd: Dan Buckingham 3rd: Clive Hopwell

This title is still open. Annie must score at least 23 points in the final round to avoid this becoming her drop score. If Dan takes maximum points with a perfect 38, Annie will need at least 28 points to secure the championship. Clive is locked into third and cannot move higher.



POCKET ROCKET NA

1st: Ryan Barker 💯

2nd: Marc Roberts 3rd: Steven Wilkinson

There is still a fight for third place. Marcin Baczkowicz has a mathematical chance to pass Steven Wilkinson. If Marcin scores well and Steven has a lower finish, the margin could close to just two points, enough to switch their positions.





CLUB 4WD

1st: Aleksander Volkov 🏆

2nd: Dean Taylor 3rd: Andy Grady

Volkov has already secured the title. The battle is for second place where only two points separate Dean Taylor and Andy Grady. Every lap will count in this fight for position.



POCKET ROCKET FI

1st: Rafail Tsartsaris 🦞

2nd: Steven House **3rd: Tommy Langley**

This class is also finely balanced. Jamie Biss is in fourth but cannot advance further. The real battle is between Steven House and Tommy Langley for second. With only three points separating them once drop scores are taken into account, a strong finish for Tommy could push him ahead.



1st: Michael Osborne

2nd: Eric Holmes 3rd: Ilya Krylov

Michael Osborne is already the 2025 champion. The real contest is between Eric Holmes and Ilya Krylov for second place. Darren, currently in fourth, cannot close the gap to third even with a maximum score.



CLUB 2WD

Leaders: David Dyson, Jonny Fletcher, Luke Capehorn

This class is one of the most open. Jonny Fletcher can still take the title from David Dyson but he will need a strong finish of 33 points or more and David would have to record no points or rely on a drop score.

Andrew Kime also has a chance to climb to third. To do this he would need a big score of at least 28.

The Pro class is confirmed. Luke Sedzikowski cannot be caught and is the 2025 Pro champion. Bradley John is secure in second and Josh Barrett holds third.

FINAL THOUGHTS

The 2025 Time Attack Championship has already crowned several champions including Volkov, Osborne, Sedzikowski, Donnelly and Barker. Yet the excitement is far from over. Clubman, Pocket Rocket NA, Pocket Rocket FI, Club 2WD and Club 4WD all

have podium positions still undecided.

The season will finish at Snetterton where one final lap from any of these drivers could change everything.







Time Attack turned 20 this year – and I've been involved, either as a commentator or driver, for practically half of that time. Throughout the many years, I've watched our beloved craft evolve, but the spirit of Time Attack (arguably the best bit) has stayed constant.

At its core used to lie the idea of "one perfect lap" – and while that remains the case, the current format introduced for this anniversary year means that drivers need to find their one perfect lap consistently, throughout the day's many competitive sessions, instead of putting it all on the line only at the end of the day. For me, and hopefully spectators, that's injected a lot more excitement into the format.

What excited me even more, however, was the variety of machines that our driver-builders brought to the track in 2025. This year we've seen the ingenuity and craftsmanship of our paddock's many gearheads, and the offerings of the aftermarket industry, hit new heights. Technologies previously reserved for OEMs and major tuning boutiques are increasingly available to the everyperson. In the world of Time Attack, anything can be made very fast indeed, especially in 2025 – regardless of marque, age or sticker price. This year's Classic and Retro class comes to mind, where we've regularly seen upgraded older chassis go toe-to-toe with much newer and shinier machinery.

This is a trend we've seen elsewhere throughout our classes, too. Take Andy Grady's Evo, for example – the only Evo in the world I'm aware of that successfully runs the Volkswagen dual-clutch DQ500 gearbox. A dreamy combination of modern technology and lighter older platforms – the best of both worlds. Of course, this is merely my personal preference; but pretty much every automotive fandom was catered for this year. Prefer supercars? Again, you're in the right place. Earlier this year we witnessed Ben Morris running his TVR Speed 12 – a true unicorn. Oh, Japanese supercars specifically? Well, we have a smattering of GTRs and the Tegiwa NSX for you, too. If you can dream it, in Time Attack you can run it.

Indeed, it feels like we've experienced another golden era of Time Attack – just in time for its anniversary. We saw an incredible roster of drivers, amazing shows, classic tracks and an exciting new format. There were fierce battles in every class, lap records were consistently smashed, and we were blown away by ever-more radical and creative builds. In a world where gearheads can feel increasingly overlooked and sidelined, Time Attack in 2025 was a much-needed oasis.

As it turns out, this was a year for the history books. Let's see if we can do even better in 2026.

Drifting remains one of the most exhilarating disciplines in motorsport, captivating fans with its blend of precision, power, and pure spectacle. With origins rooted in the mountain passes of Japan, this high-adrenaline sport has gained a loyal following in the UK, thanks in part to the rise of the Drift Pro Exhibitions and iconic venues like Brands Hatch Circuit. Here's a look into the art of drifting, its storied history, and what you can expect from one of the UK's premier drifting showcases.

What is Drifting?

Drifting is a technique in which the driver deliberately oversteers, causing the rear wheels to lose traction while maintaining full control of the car through a corner. Unlike traditional racing, where precision and lap times dominate, drifting emphasizes style, consistency, and the ability to hold long, controlled slides. The very best drivers transform each lap into a performance, managing throttle, steering, and momentum in a fine-tuned balance that creates a visual spectacle of smoke, speed, and drama.

DRIFT PRO CHAMPIONSHIP

The Origins of Drifting

Modern drifting began in Japan during the 1970s. Kunimitsu Takahashi, a former motorcycle champion, was among the first to adopt aggressive cornering techniques in car racing, inspiring a new wave of drivers.

Keiichi Tsuchiya, known globally as the "Drift King," took things further. His now-iconic Pluspy video, which featured his downhill drifting on Japanese touge roads, ignited a worldwide fascination with the sport and helped formalize drifting as a competitive discipline.

Set in Norfolk, Snetterton Race Circuit's 100 layout provides the ideal playground for drifting. With a mixture of technical corners and flowing sequences, it rewards commitment, finesse, and daring tandem battles that thrill spectators. During drift events, the 100 Circuit becomes a smoke-filled arena where style collides with speed in spectacular fashion.



The Overall title might already be decided, but plenty is still up for grabs – including the headline Class A crown – in Snetterton's Racing Hondas Championship finale. Carl McKellar explains...

Finals Day of course means added pressure, frayed nerves and terse exchanges – perfect ingredients for unexpected twists. Even scenarios that seem certain can change in an instant.

In Class A, Will Self is the favourite. With six wins in his Civic EG this season – including two on Snetterton's 300-metre layout in July – he holds a 31-point lead over Phil Wright, the only driver who can still stop him.

With bonus points to the top five in qualifying and 32 points available across two races, Self could seal the title before they've even lined up on the grid.

Wright, however, will not give up easily on his home circuit. In damper conditions – like those at Knockhill last month, and here a year ago when he won – his Civic EP3 will be at its strongest.

Other drivers could shake up the standings. Liam Collins (long overdue a first win in 2025) and Tommy Knight are nearly tied for third.

CHAMPIONSHIP INFO

The Racing Hondas Championship, run by the successful Club Time Attack organisation, features a variety of Honda models, split into three clearly defined classes based on cars' power-to-weight ratio:

- Class A: 240 bhp/ton (or 235bhp if supercharged)
- Class B: 195 bhp/ton
- Class C: 176 bhp/ton

Identical points are awarded to the top 10 finishers in each class per round:

15-12-10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1


Bonus points (all 3 classes per race):
5-4-3-2-1 to the top 5 qualifiers*
1 point to the driver setting the fastest race lap

Drivers' end-of-season total are their best 14 scores from the season's 16 rounds (although the final 2 rounds at Snetterton cannot be dropped). The driver with the highest final score – regardless of the class in which they compete – shall be crowned overall Champion.

*Race 2 features a 'reversed grid draw' (positions 4-8 in each class) following Race 1's result.


